

Scott Trevithick Bio for APA, Fall 2019

Pastor Scott Trevithick is an ordained Presbyterian minister and a member of Nevada Presbytery who has been serving as Lead Pastor at Lutheran Church of the Good Shepherd since March 2019. Good Shepherd is a congregation of the Evangelical Lutheran Church in America (ELCA), a “full communion” partner denomination with the Presbyterian Church.

Following seminary, he first served as pastor at St. John’s Presbyterian Church in Reno for over 10 years, with a focus on Children, Youth, Families, and Pastoral Care. He has specialized training and certification as an Interim Pastor and has helped a number of different congregations during times of transition. He has also worked in executive roles in the non-profit sector in the Reno area. He has served as a Volunteer Hospital Chaplain at St. Mary’s Regional Medical Center and Tahoe Forest Hospital.

He has been an instructor in the past for APA in Polity I, II, and III and for the Directory for Worship.

Scott has lived in Reno since 1995 and with his wife Kendra has a son Grant and daughter Claire.
